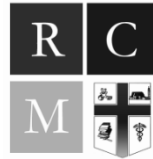

- SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Call the parish office to schedule a baptism class as well as a date for the baptism.
- RECONCILIATION is celebrated before Mass, and by appointment.
- SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: The Archdiocese requires a four-month preparation period before marriage. A couple *must* inform the Parish Office before a date is set.
- SACRAMENT OF FIRST EUCHARIST: In order to receive the sacrament of First Eucharist in Second Grade, children must regularly participate in Catholic religious education in Kindergarten and First Grade.
- CONFIRMATION: In order to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, young people must have regularly participated in Catholic religious education from First Eucharist until they are a Junior in High School. Classes are held the last Sunday of each month.
- RCIA: Adult religious education classes – every Wednesday at 7 p.m. from September through Pentecost.
- SUNDAY SCHOOL/CCD: Children/youth religious education classes every Sunday after Mass, September through May.

## FAITH IN ACTION ALABAMA (FIAAL)



Please join Faith in Action Alabama for its 2025 State Legislative Day, which will take place on Tuesday, April 1, from 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. On that day, at the Alabama State House, people of faith from throughout the state will advocate for four priorities:

- Increased state government funding for all Alabama public schools
- Medicaid Expansion
- Voting Rights
- Parole Reform
